

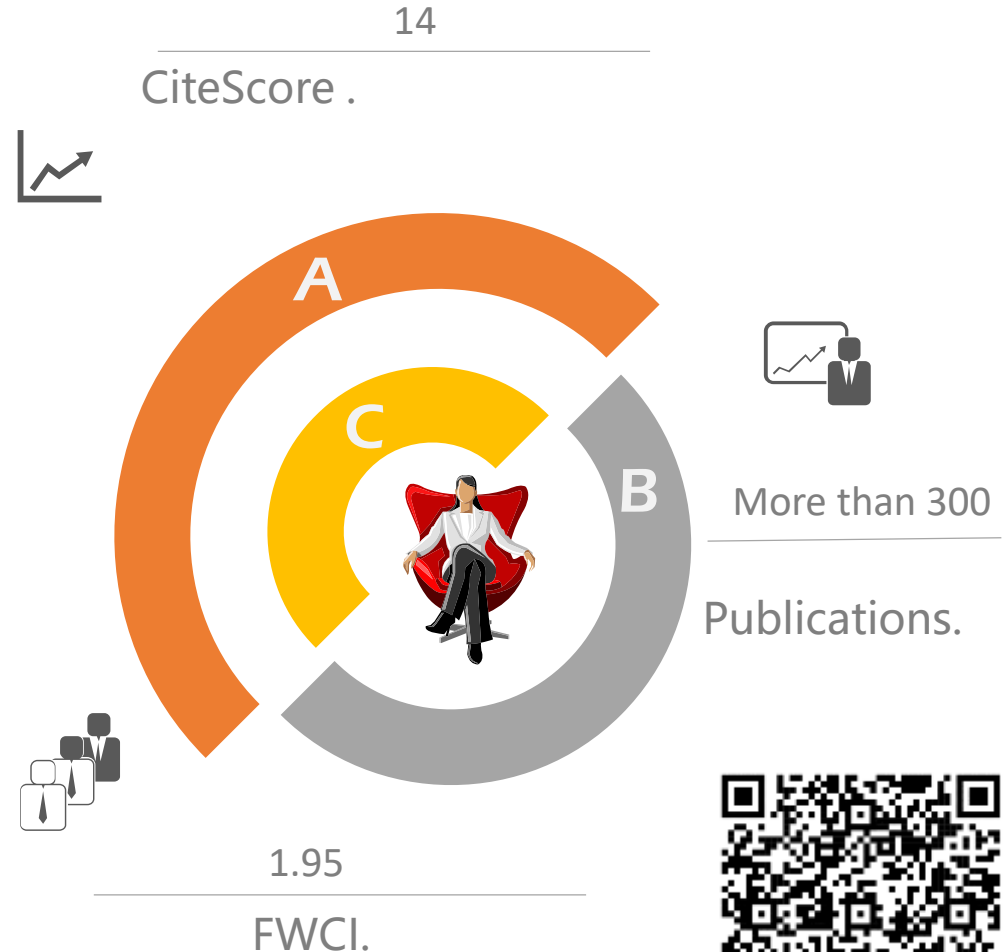
SAMSACU SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH



SamSACU has the "Architecture" faculty. The faculty has 4 departments.

- "Architecture" department
- Department of "Landscape Design".
- "Interior design" department
- Department of "Urban Planning".

There are 97 professors and teachers in the "Architecture" faculty, 21 of them have scientific degrees. In 2023, the teachers of the faculty published 4 scientific articles in Scopus and Web of Science databases, and 127 scientific articles in international journals. The number of citations to scientific proverbs is 1054.

Information resource center of Samarkand State University of Architecture and Construction was established by the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated June 20, 2006 No. PS-381

The total stock of ARM is 400,100, including 97,401 textbooks, 7,200 foreign literatures, 128,248 study guides, 57,145 fictional literatures, 103,498 scientific literatures, and 37,204 other literatures.

There are 4 classrooms with 56 seats for students. In addition, student residence No. 1 has a study hall with 14 seats, student residence No. 2 has a study room with 12 seats, student residence No. 4 has a study room with 12 seats.



95% of SamSACU students are members of the library, and more than **120** students visit the library in one day.

Zarafshon National Nature Garden : Biodiversity to his treasure travel

In our territory there are amazing valleys with unchanged nature, healing properties, the value of which is invaluable. Pure nature allows you to treat better than any doctor. Mountain Springs, dense spruce forests, thickets and clear lakes are such places. It is necessary to protect such natural beauties as eyebrows. This goal is achieved by the establishment of national parks and reserves by our state. One such small number of Parks is Zarafshan National Nature Park. It is known for its intact forests, pre-mountain toucan vegetation, biodiversity and natural conditions.

Tutor of SamSACU student deanery B. Turdiyeva and Teacher of Faculty of Architecture L. Zolotdinova organized a trip to the "Zarafshan Reserve" in order to effectively organize the free time of students of 1st and 2nd year students, as well as to protect ecology and preserve nature.

Zarafshan Park was established in 1975 in the south-east of Samarkand region, on the Right Bank of the Zarafshan River. It covers an area of more than two thousand hectares. The territory of the park is located in a narrow strip along the river, the length of which is 46 kilometers. The main goal of creating a garden is to preserve the unique plant world in its natural state. Despite its small area, fruit trees, Willow, Poplar, sea buckthorn, reeds, licorice, olives, and many other plants grow here along with the webs. Zarafshan Reserve is the only place where sea buckthorn grows.

The fauna of the garden is also very rich. It is home to more than 80 species of insects, more than 20 species of molluscs, and more than 240 vertebrates. Permanent residents include desert turtle, sand boa, lake frog, and arrow snake. It is also home to 207 species of birds and 24 species of mammals, including hedgehogs, foxes, clap foxes, ondatras, steppe mussels and quail. In 2000, attempts were also made to settle Bukharan reindeer on the territory of the Reserve.

The unique beauties and important ecological role of Zarafshan National Nature Park have also had a profound impact on students. During the trip, students became closely acquainted with the biodiversity, healing plants and fauna of Zarafshan park, further increasing their responsibility for conservation. They also became deeply aware of the importance of protection and conservation.

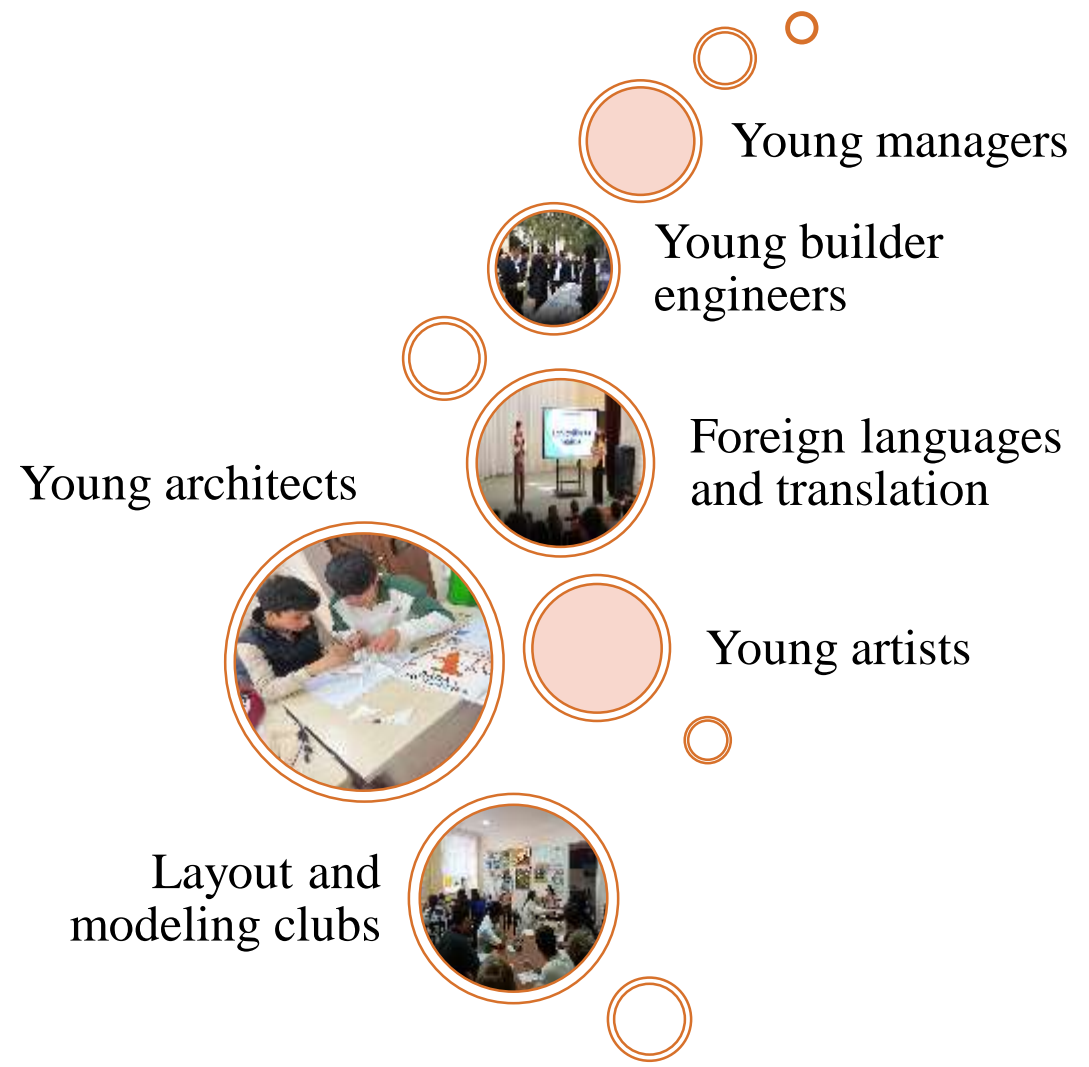

Stable practices in SAMSACU

SamSACU is located in remote areas of the city of Samarkand, and employees and students come to the University on foot, by bike, in cars, on public transport. On the territory of the university there are walkways, a place for cycling, parking lots, stops for public transport.

A large number of university staff and students use public transport, as well as additional public transport is provided to them in order to create an environmentally sustainable environment.



CHEAP ACCOMMODATION FOR STUDENTS IN SAMSACU



A total of 3 student residences have been established in SamSACU in order to provide affordable housing for students.

The total student accommodation has a capacity of 1,115. This student accommodation is 50% cheaper than the total accommodation prices.

1st A 487 seats

2-A 360 seats

4 - A 308 seats

Reduced accommodation for students is provided with free seats for students with disabilities as well as for students who are little provided.



According to the decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 9, 2021 "on measures to increase the level of accommodation of students in Higher Education Institutions of the Republic" dated 563, an additional 800-seat residential building will be built in 2024-2025 in order to provide affordable housing for SamSACU students.

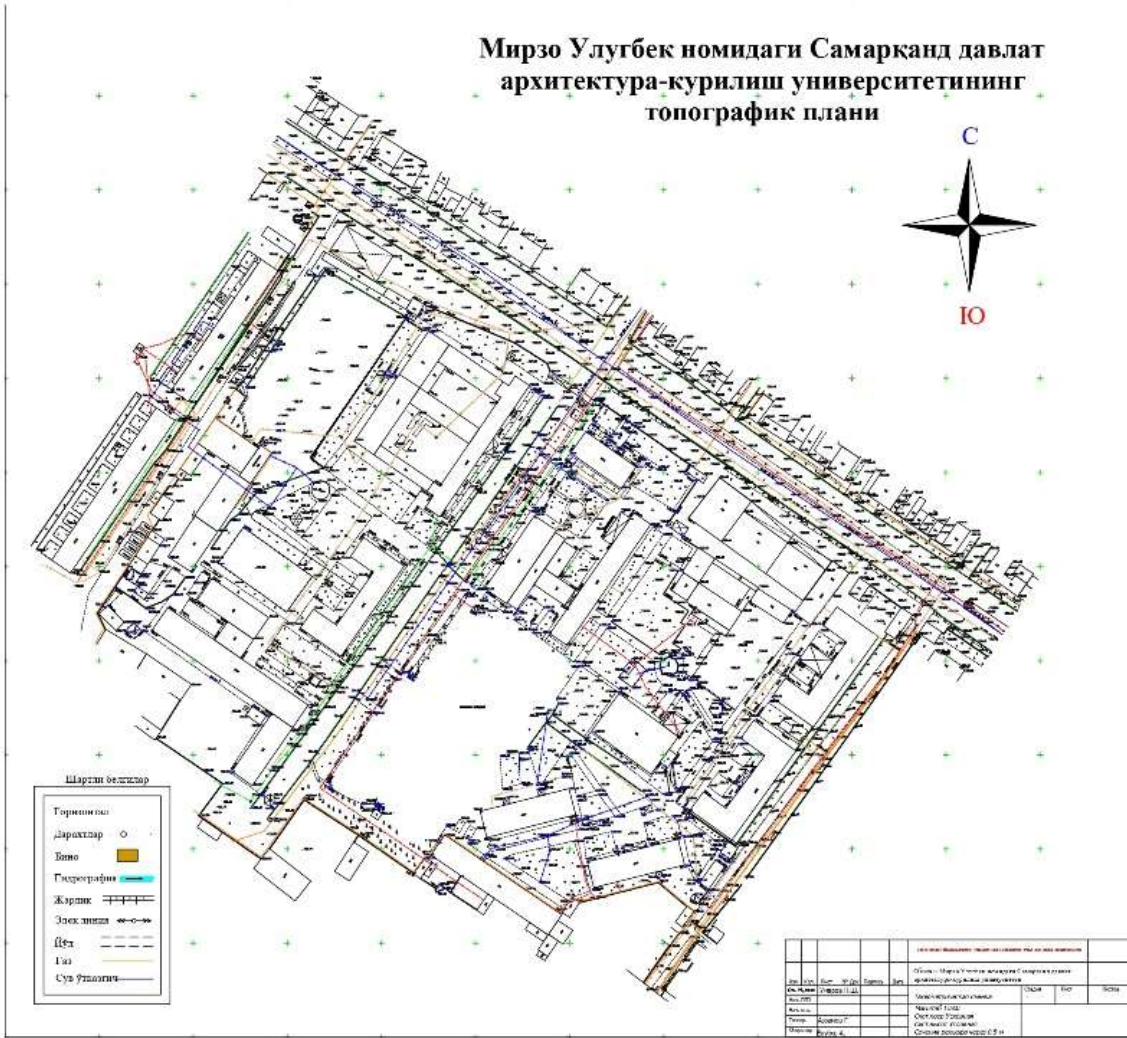


PEDESTRIAN PRIORITY ON CAMPUS IN SAMSACU

Samarkand State University of architecture and construction named after Mirzo Ulugbek has a total of 4 faculty buildings and 3 student residences, all of which are located in almost the same area. The distance between the main building and the campus is about 1 km, and on foot it is approximately 500 meters if you walk through.



CONSTRUCTION PLANNING IN SAMSACU



According to paragraph 36 of the road map for transformation and complex development of Samarkand State University of architecture and construction named after Mirzo Ulugbek, dated 08.11.2022 in PS-416, a new educational building with 3000 seats is being built in SamSACU from the place of the University's renovated kitchen building(11.4.9). In the construction of the building and other construction and planning work at the university, cooperation is being carried out with the "Sole customer" DUK.

The decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the construction and planning of the university is intended to further improve regulatory documents in the field of technical regulation on construction and housing and communal services on measures to harmonize regulatory documents in the field of construction with international standards: Eurocodes (European Codes, ES); British standards (British Standards, VS); Implementation of Chinese National Building Standards (GB, CJ, JC, JG, etc); Korean building codes (Korean building code, KVS); Russian building standards and regulations (SNIIP); US International Building Codes (International building code, IBC); Japanese national standards (Japanese Industrial Standards, JIS).
